

Camp Ridgecrest Camper Covenant

The following are the expectations required of all campers attending Camp Ridgecrest with Pritchard Memorial Baptist Church. Please review and then sign and return the

Camper Expectations:

1. Be respectful during Bible study and worship experiences.
2. Be respectful of fellow campers and counselors.
3. Participate in all scheduled camp and cabin activities on time.
4. Participate in waterfront activities only during designated times with supervision.
5. Do not tamper with other people's belongings.
6. Do not tamper with camp property or facilities. Any damage will be paid for by camper or camper's family.
7. All medications must be cleared through Camp Nurse on Monday before leaving for camp.
8. No ipods, cd players or cell phones.
9. No shaving cream.
10. No fireworks or pranks of any kind.
11. Any activity outside of the normal camp area must be accompanied by a counselor.
12. Help keep camp property, facilities, and cabins clean by throwing away trash in appropriate bins.
13. Obey curfew and no sneaking out.
- 14. A zero tolerance policy is in effect for weapons, fighting, alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products, and sexual harassment.**

Dress Code:

All clothes at camp must be modest and not violate the following. Any camper outside of the dress code will be asked to change immediately.

1. No two-piece bathing suits for girls or Speedos for boys.
2. Underwear should not be visible in public or at the waterfront.
3. No clothing promoting violence, hate, prejudice, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, gangs, nudity, profanity or pornographic images or references.
4. No excessively short mini-skirts or shorts.
5. No shirts or tank tops that overtly emphasize cleavage or midriff.
6. No cut off shirts.
7. Flip flops allowed only to and from waterfront.
8. Tennis shoes must be worn on Monday morning before boarding bus.
